40. भारत सरकार के वन एवं पर्यावरण मंत्रालय द्वारा जारी अधिसूचना दिनांक 14.8.2008 तथा संशोधित अधिसूचना दिनांक 1.9.2009 की अनुसूची की कंडिका 8(क) के अनुसार 20,000 वर्गमीटर या अधिक किन्तु 15,00,000 वर्गमीटर से कम भवन एवं संनिर्माण परियोजनाओं में तथा 8(ख) के अनुसार 50 हेक्टेयर क्षेत्र या उससे अधिक और / या 1,50,000 वर्ग मीटर या उससे अधिक निर्मित क्षेत्र के नगरीय और क्षेत्र विकास में पूर्व पर्यावरणीय स्वीकृति ली जाना अनिवार्य है। म.प्र. शासन आवास एवं पर्यावरण विभाग के झाप क्रमांक एफ-5-23/2003/32 दिनांक 14.10.2005 अनुसार भारत सरकार पर्यावरण एवं वन मंत्रालय नई दिल्ली की अधिसूचना क्रमांक एसओ 801(ई) दिनांक 7 जुलाई 2004 के परिप्रेय में पर्यावरण (संरक्षण) अधिनियम 1986 के प्रावधानों के दायरे में आती है तो इकाई प्रबंधन को / संबंधित आवेदक को नियमानुसार ई.पी.ए.एक्ट/ई.आई.ए. के तहत सख्त प्राधिकारी यथा पर्यावरण एवं वन मंत्रालय भारत सरकार अथवा State or Union territory Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) से पर्यावरणीय स्वीकृति प्राप्त करने के उपरांत ही परियोजना से जुड़े किसी भी निर्माण कार्य को प्रारंभ करना आवश्यक व अनिवार्य होगा। योजना पर्यावरण संरक्षण अधिनियम के अंतर्गत आवश्यक इन्वायरमेंट इम्पैक्ट्स असेसमेंट की कार्यवाही सुनिश्चित की जाय तथा भवन अनुज्ञा के पूर्व मध्यप्रदेश प्रदूषण नियंत्रण मण्डल से जल वायु सम्मति आवश्यक रूप से प्राप्त किया जावे तथा निर्माण के पूर्व ई.आय.ए. क्लीयरेंस लेना भी अनिवार्य होगा। संरक्षण अधिनियम संबंधी समस्त प्रावधानों का पूर्ण पालन करना आवश्यक होगा।

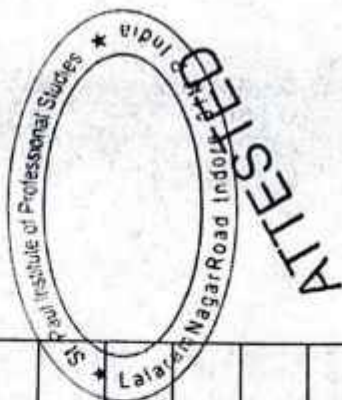

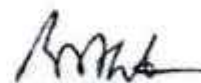

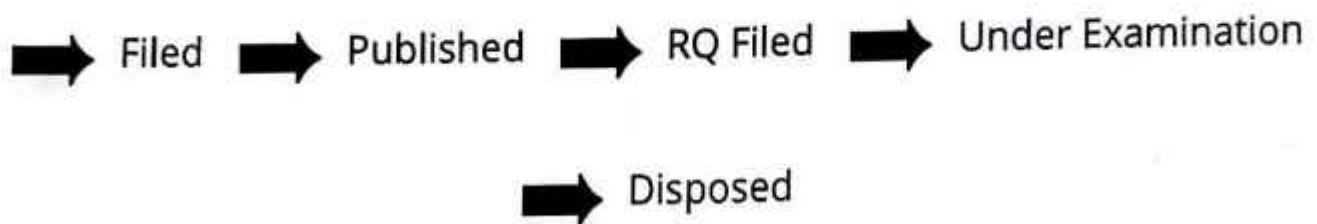
